

Rating Taxpayer-Friendly Candidates

In an effort to select local candidates for municipal offices in non-partisan elections CNHT has worked with local taxpayer groups and citizens to come up with a system of rating that will help to choose taxpayer-friendly, small-government candidates.

- *Does the local taxpayer group know the individual?*
- *Has the candidate held office and been taxpayer-friendly, small government in action?*
- *Has the candidate written a compelling statement or editorial stating commitment to low-tax small-government principles?*
- *Has the candidate taken any pledge to support low taxes and small government?*
- *Has the candidate lived in the municipality for a long time?*
- *Does the candidate bring special skills to the position for which he or she is running?*

If the local taxpayer group working with CNHT rates the candidate as “taxpayer friendly”, that is how we will rate him or her. If not, rate the candidate as “other”.
