

- 13: NO Police Sergeants' Union contract – 2% wage increases, no union concessions
- 14: NO Police Patrolmen's Union contract – 2% wage increases, no union concessions

**All 3 contracts are substantially more than contracts turned down by voters in 2008.
Evergreen clauses will lock the Town into these Contracts indefinitely.**

- 15: NO \$177,000 Decorative sidewalk lights at beach from special revenue parking lot fund.
- 16: YES \$38,650 From the sale of cemetery lots to Cemetery Burial Trust Fund
- 17, 18 & 19: YES Special Revenue funds No tax impact.
- 20: YES \$300,000 Use money from Road Improvement Fund to improve roads. No tax impact.
- 21: NO \$223,000 Salt storage shed. Good idea, but too costly, with too few details.
- 22: YES \$35,000 Town office. Install generator and improve electrical and plumbing systems.
- 23: NO \$576,360 For pumper truck spread over 48 months. Lacks financial justification.
- 24: YES \$50,000 Conceptual plans and cost estimates for upgrading Winnacunnet Road fire station to headquarters.
- 25: NO \$340,000 Public Works Equipment Capital Reserve Fund. Public trust violated in 2008's car purchase, leaving a balance \$318,000 from last year's \$340,000 appropriation.
- 26: YES \$50,000 to spray mosquitoes.
- 27, 28 & 29: NP \$178,151 total for all human service agency warrant articles.
- 30: YES Establishes compensated leave fund.
- 31: NP Amusement ordinance amendments.
- 32: YES Remove cats from pet ordinance.
- 33: YES Solid Waste Ordinance, authorizes Selectmen to implement Mandatory Recycling.
- 34: YES Remove authority for Selectmen to sell town-owned property on the Seabrook side of the Hampton River. Only Town Meeting should have this authority.
- 35: YES Accept Riverview Terrace, Bragg Avenue, Tuttle Avenue, Fellows Avenue, and Dow Avenue as public roads.
- 36: YES Accept Rosa Road and Warner Lane as public roads.
- 37: NO Accept Manchester Street as is. Potential expense to the town.
- 38: YES Petition State to remove railroad bridge on Drakeside Road
- 39: NO Give up town land to Galley Hatch for Winnacunnet intersection changes. More info needed.
- 40: NO The town should not be in electric utility business.
- 41: NP Old Stage Road Bridge for bikes and pedestrians.
- 42: YES Renew lease for existing Ashworth Avenue fire station.
- 43: YES Rye sewage agreement. First step to allow for termination.
- 44: NP Rye sewage agreement ---shall not renew. Second step in the process to allow for termination.
- 45: YES Allows the town clerk to accept credit cards with a fee for the service costs.
- 46: NO \$30,000 Pavilion. With all respect to veterans, other options are available.
- 47: NO Article mandates town to purchase recycled products at an increased price.
- 48: YES Makes public event recycling mandatory.
- 49: NO Establish Recycling Education fund. Education costs are in the Operating Budget.
- 50: NO Retain requirement for town meeting vote.
- 51: NO Authorizes Second Town Meeting for union contracts if contracts fail.
