## The time to act is NOW!

Bond interest rates are low, but the expectation is they will rise soon. (2.2% interest on a 20-years bond is the rate we are being offered now.)

Construction costs have gone up 10-12% over the past two years, with no sign of reversing. Newbury has no outstanding bonds right now.
