

## Article 1: Bedford High School

The average annual tax increase \* over a ten-year period is



compared to the 20-year Manchester tuition proposal.

Bedford has to pay \$10.6 million in capital costs to Manchester. Instead of funding further capital projects in Manchester, for an additional two dimes per year, we can build and operate a high school in Bedford and control how our money is spent.

## Article 2: Intermediate School

The average annual tax increase \* over a ten-year period is compared to not building an Intermediate School.



Bedford schools are **269 students over capacity today**. As the student population continues to grow, NOTHING will not be an acceptable option as **costly temporary classrooms will need to be added**. Also by voting for this on Tuesday, the School District can take advantage of lower labor costs in the winter months, plus lock in a low interest rate.
