## **Article 1: Bedford High School**

The average annual tax increase \* over a ten-year period is



compared to the 20-year Manchester tuition proposal.

Bedford has to pay \$10.6 million in capital costs to Manchester. Instead of funding further capital projects in Manchester, for an additional two dimes per year, we can build and operate a high school in Bedford and control how our money is spent.

## **Article 2: Intermediate School**

The <u>average annual tax increase</u>\* over a ten-year period is compared to not building an Intermediate School.



Bedford schools are **269** students over capacity today. As the student population continues to grow, NOTHING will not be an acceptable option as costly temporary classrooms will need to be added. Also by voting for this on Tuesday, the School District can take advantage of lower labor costs in the winter months, plus lock in a low interest rate.
