

Coming week:

House Session –Thursday

HB 367 - SUPPORT OTPA – increase the Education Freedom Account family income limit from 300% of federal poverty to 350%. This would be approximately a \$10,000 cap increase for a single mom and her child. With the current cost of living increases, we owe it to lower income families to help them provide the educational options to meet the educational needs of their children.

HB 464 – SUPPORT OTP – expands the EFA program by providing certain at risk groups eligibility with no family income cap. These groups include foster care children, children who are in failing schools, children who have been persistently bullied, children with special needs and those with a parent in the armed forces.

Education Committee Voting this week:

HB 552 - incentive grants for school districts showing gains in student achievement (reward success) SUPPORT

HB 553 – require schools to post positions and salaries (# and salaries of administrators vs teachers) SUPPORT

HB451 – attack on private schools by requiring them to admit all students regardless of their ability to provide specific disability services or hire teachers who do not believe the school's religious character. OPPOSE

CACR7 – repeal the unconstitutional and anti-religious Blaine amendment that does not allow public funds to go to religious schools. SUPPORT

HB516 – providing for freedom of speech and association on public colleges. SUPPORT

HB 61 – repeals the anti-discrimination statutes related to instruction that one race is superior to another or that an individual by virtue of their race is inherently racist, or oppressive. OPPOSE

HB104 – requiring that multi-stall bathroom and lockers rooms be limited to use by the same sex. SUPPORT

HB331 – eliminates the Education Freedom program family income limit. SUPPORT

HB432 – require the family income of EFA students to be checked annually. OPPOSE

Judiciary Committee voting this week:

HB224 – repeals the penalties of our Fetal Life Protection Act which bans abortions after 24 weeks with exceptions for the life of the mother and fatal fetal abnormalities. OPPOSE

HB271 – repeals the Fetal Life Protection Act. OPPOSE

HB346 – Born Alive Protection Act requires medical care for babies born alive after a botched abortion SUPPORT

HB 562 – requires informed consent of the mother prior to an abortion. SUPPORT

HB88 – forbids the state from interfering with a mother’s decision for abortion. OPPOSE

HB591 – forbids an abortion after the detection of a fetal heartbeat SUPPORT
