<u>HB 1291</u> – OPPOSE – This bill allowing accessory dwelling units by right will eventually be heard in the <u>Senate Commerce Committee</u> (Date TBD) You can email the whole committee before the date is posted. Or you can wait for us to post the hearing date when the <u>Senate Portal</u> will become available. Ask them to be sure to record the testimony.

<u>SB 454</u> – <u>OPPOSE</u> – This bill allows for putting \$10M of your tax dollars into a housing fund and was sent to <u>House Ways and Means Committee</u> who determined it should go to interim study so **no action is required at the moment**.

OTHER ISSUES – IMMIGRATION

<u>SB 563</u> – **SUPPORT** – The <u>House Criminal Justice and Public Safety Committee</u> will hold a **Public Hearing: 04/17/2024 11:30 am LOB 202-204.** You can register your Support via the <u>House Portal</u>. This bill now covers **protection against squatters**. The bill is relative to federal immigration enforcement.

<u>SB 358</u> – <u>SUPPORT</u> – This bill regards invalidating out-of-state driver's licenses issued to undocumented immigrants and passed the Senate. It has crossed over to the <u>House Transportation Committee</u>. (Hearing Date TBD)

<u>HB 1665</u> – <u>SUPPORT</u> – This bill to **expand Education Freedom Accounts** will be heard by the <u>Senate</u> <u>Education Committee</u> on <u>04/16/2024</u>, Room 101, LOB, 09:20 AM. Please use the <u>SENATE PORTAL</u> to register your <u>SUPPORT</u>.
